AGES: Children in Grades One through Six.

OUR PROGRAM

- We offer children a variety of activities: blocks, manipulative toys such as Lego, games and puzzles, creative play, arts and crafts, books, cooking activities and lots of outdoor play at the Windsor Park School playground.
- We offer full day care on days such as school PD Days and school breaks such as Spring Break.
- Fieldtrips on most full days.
- A fun-filled summer program for which children can be registered by the week or by the month.
- Swimming and karate lessons are available for an extra fee.
- Special events: Family pizza dinner, talent Show and family BBQ

OUR STAFF

- Staff members have Child Care qualification certificates, first aide and security

clearances.

- Our staff members are caring, have relevant training and are committed to providing quality child care.

REGISTRATION

WE CURRENTLY HAVE SPACES AVAILABLE FOR SEPTEMBER 2018.

- Registration for September care begins in late April.
- If spaces cannot be filled by children from Windsor Park other children will be accepted if their parents provide transportation.
- There may be part-week spaces available (for example, Mondays-Wednesdays-Fridays).
- Children may be placed on the waiting list eighteen months before they begin Grade One.
