

SCHOOL SUPPLY INSTRUCTIONS

Dear parents and grade three students,

I would like to welcome you and your child to the grade three classroom beginning August 29 at 8:30 a.m. It is going to be a very exciting year with so much to learn and explore!

The following is a list of school supplies and instructions to prepare for our first day of school together. To ensure that things run smoothly, it will be very important for parents to organize and label supplies as follows:

Duotangs	Write your child's name on each duotang and label as follows:
3 - Blue	Math Problem Solving, Math Unit 1 and Math Unit 2
1 - Green	Social Studies
1 - Yellow	Health
3 - Red	Only Label the following two: Novel Study Mad Minutes
1 - Orange	Handwriting
1 - Purple	Music

Exercise Books	Write your child's name on each exercise book and label as follows:
Book 1 - ½ blank ½ lined	Spelling Tests
Book 2, 3, 4, 5	No labels
Book 6 - blank	Math Journals

Plastic Pencil Box	Write your child's name on the pencil case/box and place the following labelled items inside:
2	40g glue sticks
1	Sharpie fine-tipped permanent marker (black)
2	Sharpie ultra fine tipped marker (black)
2	HB pencils (please pre sharpen at home and wrapped in an elastic band)
2	White erasers – Staedtler (large)
3	Highlighters (yellow, green, orange)
1	Staedtler pencil sharpener with lid - MUST have a lid

Large Ziploc Freezer Bag	Write your child's name on each item and place them in the Ziploc Freezer Bag:
Bag 1	1 - Wireless mouse for computer use 1 - Headphones - for computer use 1 - Pointed scissors
Bag 2	1 - Mr. Sketch 12 scented markers 1 - Crayola 12 washable fine tipped markers 1 - Crayola 24 pencil crayons (pre-sharpened) 1 - 30cm clear plastic ruler (cm/mm)
Bag 3	Extra Supplies: Watercolour paints Pastels (Both items can be gently used items)

Individual Items	Write your child's name on each item and send them separately with everything listed above:
1	Non-marking <u>running</u> shoes
1	Box of facial tissue (210 sheets)
3	Large Ziploc freezer bags
1	Red twin pocket Folder - lettersize
1	Non-spill refillable water bottle
1	Bristol board (white)
1	Roll of Transparent tape
