GRADE 5 SCHOOL SUPPLY INSTRUCTIONS

I would like to welcome you and your child to the grade five classroom beginning August 29 at 8:30 a.m. It is going to be a very exciting year with so much to learn and explore!

The following is a list of school supplies and instructions to prepare for our first day of school together. To ensure that things run smoothly, it will be very important for parents to organize and label supplies as follows:

Duotangs	Write your child's name on each duotang and label as follows:
Red - 1	Math Exercises
Purple - 2	English (add some lined paper)
Green - 1	Science
Yellow - 1	Weekly Work
Blue - 1	Social Studies
Black - 1	French (add some lined paper)
Orange - 1	Music (add some lined paper)
White - 1	Health (add some lined paper)

Scribblers	Write your child's name on each exercise book and label as follows:
Book 1	Personal journal
Book 2	Writer's Workshop
Book 3	Math Workbook

Exercise Book	Write your child's name on each exercise book and label as follows:
Book 1	Math Journal

Pencil Case/Box	Write your child's name on the pencil case/box and place the following labelled items inside:
1	Basic Calculator
1	20g glue sticks
1	Paper Mate FLAIR medium tip Pen (black)
10	HB pencils
1	White erasers – Staedtler
1	Staedtler Pencil Sharpener with Lid
1 of each kind	Sharpies Black (ultra fine and fine)
1	Highlighter
1	Scissors
1	Pencil crayons already sharpened
1	Set of Markers

Large Ziploc Freezer Bag	Write your child's name on each item and place them in the Ziploc Freezer Bag:
Bag 1	Post it notes Pencil crayons Small set of headphones for chromebook use (not earbuds) Ruler All additional paper

Individual Items	Write your child's name on each item and send them separately with everything listed above:
1	Non-marking running shoes
1	Box of Facial Tissue (210 sheets)
6	Large Ziplock Bags
1	Non-spill refillable water bottle

Please place all remaining school supply items from your Write-On Stationery order in a bag and keep them in a safe place at home until your child needs to replenish them.
