



SCHOOL SUPPLY INSTRUCTIONS

Dear parents and grade one students,

I would like to welcome you and your child to the grade one classroom this coming September. It is going to be a very exciting year with so much to learn and explore!

The following is a list of school supplies and instructions to prepare for our first day of school together.

Do not label these items:

- 4 Hilroy 1/2 Blank 1/2 Interlined Exercise Books
- 4 Hilroy Interlined Exercise Books
- 4 - Large Ziploc Bags (27 x 28 cm)
- 1 - Box of Facial Tissue (210 sheets)
- 1 - Bristol Board (2 ply) - White
- 1 - Sharpie Marker-Black (Fine Tipped)-Permanent
- 4 - Medium Ziploc Bags (18 x 20 cm)

Please label these items:

- 4 - Papermate FLAIR Medium Tip Pen (black)
- 12- HB Pencils (Ticonderoga tri- write - please pre sharpen at home)
- 2 - White Erasers – Staedtler
- 4- 20g Glue Sticks
- 1 - File Folder (Legal Size – blue)
- 1 - Crayola 24 Wax Crayons
- 1 - Elmer's **40ml** White Glue
- 1 - Plastic re closable Envelope, letter size, Winnable Brand (For home reading books)
- 1 - The Pencil Grip
- 3- Duotangs (Blue, Green, Yellow) not plastic
- 2 - plastic Pencil Box (Staples brand)
- 1 – Staedtler Pencil Sharpener with Lid
- 2 – EXPO fine tip whiteboard markers (black)
- 1 – Small Whiteboard eraser (EXPO makes a nice size)

1- Small set of Headphones for ipad use (not ear buds)

One pair of **running shoes** for use only in the gym and classroom

One sturdy backpack for transporting daily work and books

Your child's first pencil box should contain 2 sharp pencils, the pencil grip, one eraser, one glue stick, Crayola crayons and the 40 ml bottle of white glue. The second box should contain: extra pencils, extra glue sticks, and erasers, flair pens, whiteboard pens and a small whiteboard eraser.

It is best to label each individual crayon, glue stick, pen and pencil.
