



## SCHOOL SUPPLY INSTRUCTIONS

The following is a list of school supplies and instructions to prepare for our first day of school together.

1 - 100 Page Plain Looseleaf

2 - 200 Page Ruled Looseleaf

1 - 50 Page Graph Looseleaf 4x1"

4 - White Erasers - Staedtler (large)

2 - Glue Sticks (40g)

5 - Red Pens

24 - HB Pencils (please sharpen at home)

1 - Crayola 24 Pencil Crayons (pre-sharpened)

1 - Crayola 12 Washable Markers (Fine Tipped)

1 - 8 PRANG Washable Watercolor Paints

3 - Box of Facial Tissue (126 Sheets)

1- Scotch Magic Tape

2 - Sharpie Marker Permanent (ultra fine tip) Black

6 - Highlighters (yellow, orange, and green - two of each color)

2 - Sharpie Marker-Black (Fine Tipped)-Permanent
